SCHOLARSHIPS

The Richard Daoust Scholar-Athlete Memorial Award

There will be a \$500 scholarship awarded to one player chosen by the selection committee after carefully considering all applicants.

The award is eligible to players meeting the following criteria:

- a graduating senior
- has played 2 years of varsity soccer
- Possesses an academic average of 90% or higher, verified by official transcript or school guidance counselor.
- Must be an exemplary citizen
- Must demonstrate participation in community service.
- Must submit a 250 word essay defining leadership and your role as a leader in your school as an athlete, student and person.

Applicants must provide two (2) letters of recommendation from someone other than his coach. Suggestions: guidance counselor, athletic director, teacher.

The Mike Dillon Memorial Award

There will be a \$500 scholarship awarded to one player chosen by the selection committee after careful considering all applicants.

The criteria for the Mike Dillon Scholarship will be the same as the Richard Daoust Scholarship except for two modifications:

- Applicant must possess an academic average of 80% or higher, verified by official transcript or school guidance counselor.
- Applicant must submit a 250 word essay defining work ethic and the role a strong work ethic has played in your development as a student and athlete.

Scholar Athlete Award

There will be a \$500 scholarship awarded to one player chosen by the selection committee after careful considering all applicants.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a graduating senior
- Must have played varsity soccer for 2 years
- Applicant must have a cumulative high school average of 90% or higher and submit an official transcript or letter from a guidance counselor verifying the average.
- Applicant must submit a 250 word essay explaining what it means to be a scholar-athlete.

PassBack (Unsung Hero) Award

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a graduating senior
- Must have played varsity soccer for at least 1 year
- Must Applicant must have a cumulative high school average of 80% or better and submit an official high school transcript or a letter from a guidance counselor verifying the average.
- Applicant must submit an essay detailing how he has given back to the game of soccer over the past year. (ex: volunteer work with local club, officiating) and why it is important to give back to the game of soccer. A minimum of 10 hours for the year are required and must be verified.
